

Pierce County Trail Days Activity Hosting

ForeverGreen Trails supports the development of a unified system of trails throughout Pierce County, WA, via education, advocacy, promotion, and collaboration. Trail Days is our largest annual event, involving dozens of activities that have engaged thousands of people of all ages and abilities across Pierce County, from Mount Rainier to the Key Peninsula!

We invite you to host one or more activities on Trail Days.* You'll be in great company — city and county parks departments, public agencies, non-profits, clubs, socially-minded businesses, and informal groups who love the outdoors all take part. These amazing hosts have offered hikes, park/trail maintenance work parties, bike rides, bird watching and native plant walks, historical walking tours, skateboarding, and much, much more — see <u>past Trail Days</u> reports for examples. Hosting a Trail Days activity is easy:

- Use your imagination: Any activity encouraging people to get outside and get active, that fosters stewardship of parks and trails, or in general celebrates and normalizes active recreation and mobility is great. <u>Think about how your activity can serve an</u> <u>existing initiative of your organization</u>. Talk with friends or colleagues and dream up something exciting to make a buzz — a virtual 5K race, a photo booth for people and their pets enjoying a trail, a scavenger hunt that educates people about your group's mission — the possibilities are endless so get creative! Hint: we consider trails very broadly so any "route" can be a trail for Trail Days. Note: Trail Days is all about being <u>active</u> — tabling doesn't work unless it's part of a larger opportunity you offer the public.
- 2. Fill out the online host signup form on the <u>Trail Days webpage</u> by July 20th! If you are planning more than one event, please fill out a form for **each** event. You can add or change events later. You may place restrictions on your events such as group size, require liability waivers, etc. It's all your call!
- 3. Hold your activity: Most activities are just 3-4 hours long from setup to pack-up.

ForeverGreen Trails handles basic Trail Days outreach — Facebook events, online social media campaign, press releases for media promotion, etc. However, for the best promotional coverage, **most hosts do additional promotion through their own outreach channels**.

We just ask two things: **please let US set up the Facebook event** for the activity so they retain a consistent Trail Days look-and-feel for the public (we will invite you to be co-hosts so you can add/change event details. Also, in your outreach **please identify your activity as part of Pierce County Trail Days coordinated by ForeverGreen Trails** (we can provide our organization's logo if needed).
