## **Highlights of 2024 Trail Days Activities**

### **Alchemy Skateboarding & Pierce County Parks**

Scores of people showed up for a multi-activity event at Sprinker Recreation Center and the adjacent Bresemann Forest. A guided walk was offered by the County's Natural Lands Steward, a scavenger hunt educated people about plants and wildlife, a build-a-kite activity, and a casual group skateboard cruise to nearby Spanaway Park (and back) rounded out the offerings.

The Bresemann Forest activity saw between 120-150 people who walked the trails, participated in outdoor yoga, or scaled the Spire Rock climbing facility. The Sprinker Recreation Center has been undergoing extensive outdoor improvements and Trails Day was a soft re-opening for the public, with a larger grand reopening to follow.

#### **Clover Creek Habitat Stewardship**

This habitat stewardship event included work in the riparian zone along Clover Creek. Nine volunteers helped remove invasive plant species, care for native trees, and remove trash.



# East Tacoma Community Leaders (ETCL) & Montañistas de Washington

Swan Creek Park Walk & Cleanup New Trail Days partner Montañistas de Washington joined local grassroots organizers ETCL for a social walk and litter



cleanup event at Swan Creek Park. Ten participants gathered to care for this well-used park in Tacoma's most diverse neighborhood. They gathered 13 large bags of litter and two car tires throughout their 4-mile walk in the park.

#### Foothills Rails to Trails Coalition & Pierce County Parks

#### East Puyallup Trailhead Grand Reopening & Stewardship

This celebration of a much-anticipated reopening of the newly expanded Foothills National Recreational Trail trailhead was complemented by a volunteer stewardship activity to remove invasive plants and improve sight clearances for trail users.

#### Foothills Rails to Trails Coalition — All Along the Riverwalk

FGT member and frequent partner Foothills held their All Along the Riverwalk Arts, Education & Entertainment Festival on Trails Day this year. They estimate that between 700-1000 people passed through or came to the festival to enjoy music and art at the various booths.

#### Queers for Conservation — 2024 Earth Gay

In cooperation with Metro Parks Tacoma, 74 volunteers worked to improve the trails and grounds at Wapato Hills Park. They spread 8 yards of gravel to resurface trails, cleared over 500 square feet of invasive noxious tansy, and collected 24 bags of trash, all within an hour! All of the stewardship goals were quickly completed so everyone could enjoy playing games in the park like giant Jenga and cornhole. Several partners had information tables as well, including Tacoma Pride, WA Conservation Action, and Tacoma Tree Foundation.



# <u>Tacoma Washington Bicycle Club</u> & Campfire Coffee Tacoma Water Flume and Pipeline Trail Tour

Ten riders met up at locally owned Campfire Coffee for a 15-mile ride around Tacoma featuring the Water Flume Trail and Pipeline Trail. This is the third year that Campfire and TWBC have partnered to cohost this event.



<u>Washington Trails Association</u> — Trail Building at Rainier Woods Park, South Hill, Puyallup Long-time Trail Days partner, WTA hosted a trail building workparty. It was attended by 10 participants including one youth. The group put in 83 hours of work total and built 300 ft of new trail.
